

Medibio partners with HBF and Vital Conversations on Australia's biggest mental health check-in

Sydney, Australia – 11 October 2016: Medibio Limited (MEB or the Company) has signed on as a delivery partner on a mental health campaign led by corporate psychological health services organisation, Vital Conversations and in conjunction with not-for-profit health insurer, HBF.

Launching this week, the *Australia's Biggest Mental Health Check-in* campaign encourages Australians to undertake a mental health check facilitated by Vital Conversations. Participants will receive their confidential results from 10 November 2016 and collective, anonymous results will also be mapped to provide a comprehensive assessment of Australia's mental health.

Vital Conversations has adopted Medibio's world-first objective method stress measure for the campaign. Vital Conversations will be applying its own self-report based, subjective diagnostic methodology, Vital Pulse, to provide rounded initial assessments and recommendations to campaign participants.

Within the campaign, HBF is working closely with Medibio to encourage its corporate clients to participate in the initiative, in what will effectively be a trial of Medibio's workplace stress diagnostic methodology.

Other real benefits to Medibio will be the awareness created for its workplace stress product prior to commercial launch, along with the expected 3,000 new de-identified data files with corresponding stress assessments. This data will more than quadruple the size of Medibio's dedicated overnight CHR file database and corresponding stress assessments.

Other organisations that have signed up to participate in *Australia's Biggest Mental Health Check-In* to date include Wesfarmers, Broadspectrum and Interwork.

The launch coincided with World Mental Health Day; the beginning of Mental Health Week in Western Australia and other mental health awareness periods across Australia during October.
